**CRITERIA FOR REST AND STRESS CONTRAST
ECHOCARDIOGRAMS INTERPRETATION**

To be qualified to read Contrast Echocardiograms, the individual is required to be a member of the Noninvasive Cardiology Reading Panel or to have echocardiography reading privileges at Kettering Memorial Hospital.

One of the following educational criteria is to be met:

- Contrast echo training as part of Cardiology Fellowship as documented by the program director.
- Currently active privileges in the interpretation of contrast echocardiograms at other facilities.
- Attendance at Contrast Echo Course emphasizing interpretation.
- Tutorial on Contrast Echo interpretation (individual or small group).
